BUILDING WORKS 2011-2012

During the current major building project, to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee of The Queen's reign, we much regret being unable to offer any refreshments after services on Sunday morning. However this will resume as soon as the work allows. The project, which is scheduled for completion in June 2012, will extend the Royal Robing Room, create new offices for the Chaplain and the Steward and a new external sunken courtyard from which steps will give access to the chapel garden. Two new windows will connect the ante-chapel and the new courtyard, and, for the first time, illuminate the former area with daylight.
